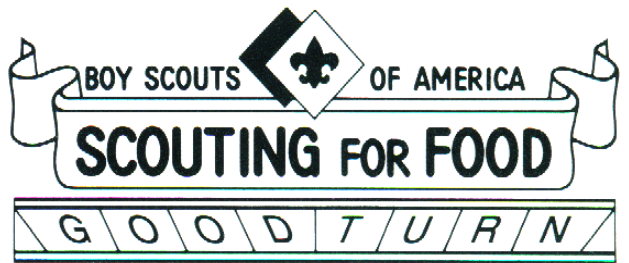

Go to our council website, click on the publicity link, and all press contacts are listed, along with how to do a news release. Send it in to us to get \$5 for your unit account!

The door hangers will come ready to write in the date your scouts will pick-up the food. You do not have to conduct your drive on the date in the calendar. Do what works best for your unit!
