Cub Scout Leader Specific Training

This training is designed for learning the Pack, Den, and committee operations to effectively deliver a fun program.

Boy Scout Leader Specific Training

This training allows you to learn Troop operations and the patrol method so you can facilitate exciting outdoor programs.

Outdoor Skills Weekend

This outdoor classroom allows Boy Scout leaders and Webelos Den Leaders to practice practical applications of basic scout skills.

BALOO (Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation)

Pack's must have a "trained" BALOO leader to present an overnight camping program. This course teaches the skills to ensure a successful overnight campout for your pack.

Venture Leader Specific Training

This training is specific to working with young adults in leadership and activity planning.

District Committee and Chartered Organization Representative Training

This is geared especially for district operations, committee specific functions, and chartered partner relationships to help enhance our unit's delivery of program to youth.

Commissioner Training

This training is to assist commissioners in providing quality relationships with the units they cover. It is conducted every year on an as needed basis. There also is a College of Commissioner Science advanced training offered annually that involves many councils, which is offered annually by the Greater Niagara Frontier Council.
